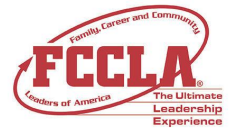

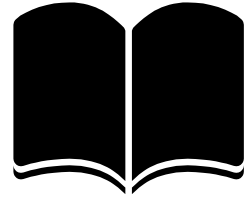

If you answered mostly Es . . .

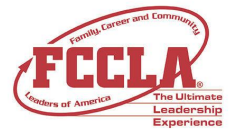
