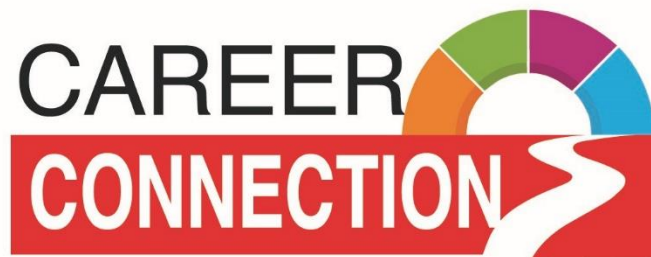

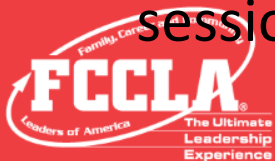

- **President:** The Area meeting of Minnesota FCCLA is now in session. Let us repeat our creed.

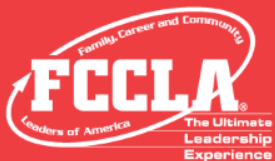

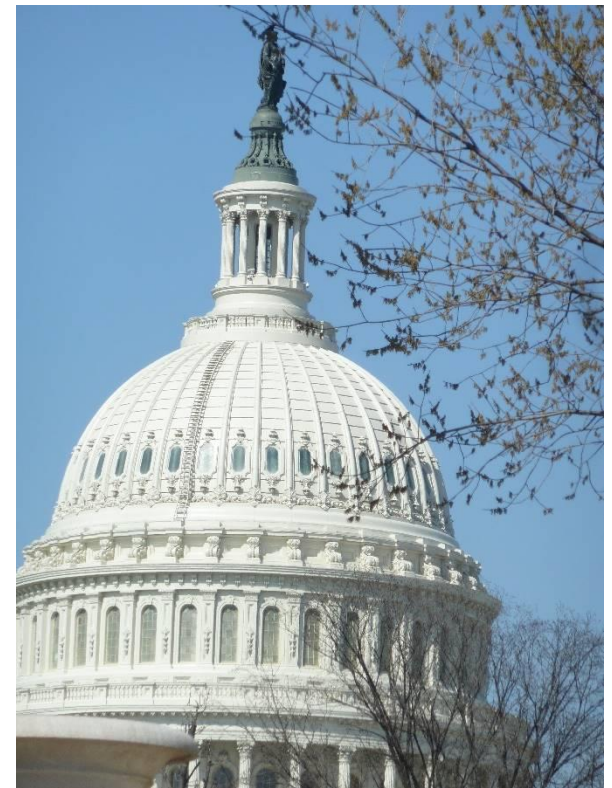
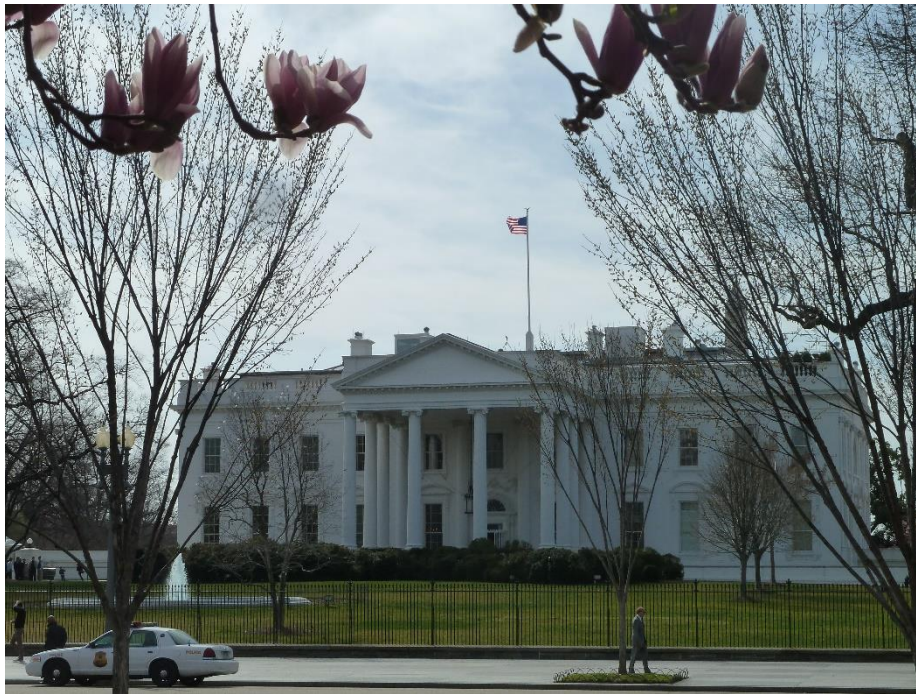
Triple Crown- Chapter Award 2020

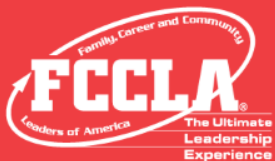

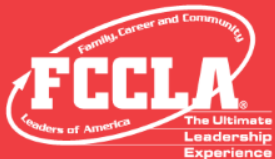
Chapter's that retain members?

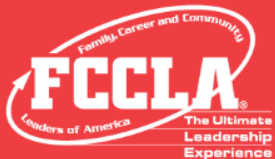

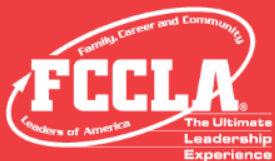
