Activity 3 Materials Needed: Device, Filmora Meme Maker, Canva Poster Maker

Students will be instructed to make an FCCLA meme (10 minutes) or a Canva Poster (40 minutes) with a partner. Students can create a meme/poster on FCCLA facts/history, STAR Event involvement, National Program details, or membership campaigns.
