FCCLA IS CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

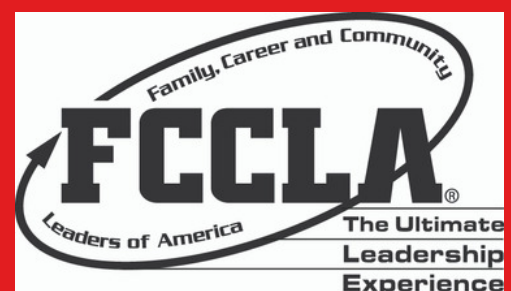

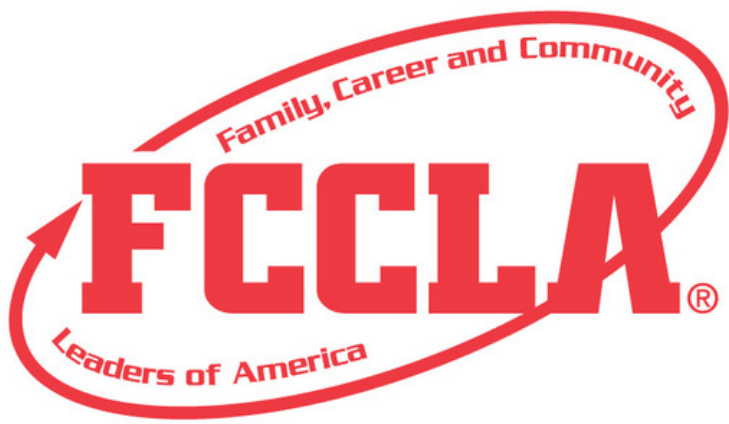

FCCLA offers unique advantages for students

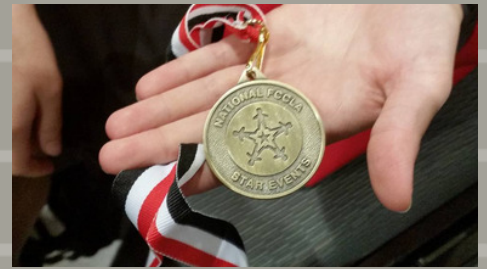

- * FCCLA offers recognition for a diverse population of students, including some who tend not to be active participants in school activities.**



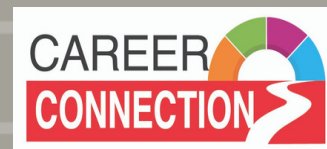
Competitive Events
