- Exploring opportunities to practice and develop these skills



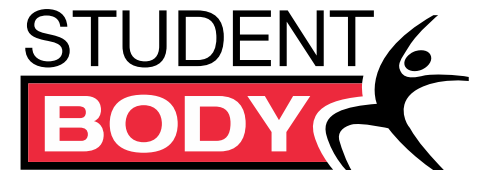


CAREER PATHWAYS
