Hygiene Drive

Partner with local efforts to help those in need by collecting and donating essential items.

Items to collect (check in with place you are donating to as well):

- Hand Soaps
- Toothbrushes & toothpastes
- Shampoo
- Conditioner

- Floss
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Deodorant
- Razors
- Shaving cream
- Hairbrushes

Where to donate to:

- Local homeless shelter
- Local food shelf

Tie Blankets

Create and give cozy blankets for people who could use some of your group's kindness.

Items needed for 1 blanket:

- 2 different fabrics
 - 1.5 yards for a kid-sized blanket or 2 yards for an adult-sized blanket
- Fabric scissors
- Ruler

Lay fabrics with both backsides facing each other

Cut strips 1-2 inches wide and 6 inches long around the entire blanket

Then tie together all of the strips (if you want the ties to be more secure double tie the strips)

Where to donate to:

- A Homeless shelter
- A Children's Hospital
- A Nursing Home
- A Veterans Home

Writing letters to Vets and active service members

Create your own handmade cards (or use pre-made ones that can be sent out from the State Office) and distribute them to Vets through local services like the VA or send them to the State office to get delivered to active service members through [Operation Gratitude](#).
