## Fire and Severe Weather Instructions – DoubleTree Hotel 2026

### In the Event of a Fire Evacuation

- If you are in a **guest room**, when the fire alarm sounds, proceed to the nearest stairwell, one of which is located on each end of the corridor. **DO NOT USE THE ELEVATORS.**
  - The stairwells will lead you directly outside of the building.
- On the **second floor meeting level**: use the exits in front and back of the Grand Ballroom. Follow the exit signs to the stairwell to the Garden Court Area and out the South exit.
- On the **foyer side second floor level**: follow the stairs by the pool area, by the Bloomington room or by the coatroom to exit the building.
- On the **first level** there are exits on every side of the building: Plaza Tower, Garden Court and Vista Tower/Main Lobby.
- The Hotel will provide an 'all clear' announcement when it is safe to return into the building.

### In the Event of Severe Weather/Tornado

- If you are in your guest room, please remain there and go into the bathroom, close the door, and crouch in the bathtub/shower.
- If you are on the first or second floor of the building, in public space, proceed to the Aspen and Oak restaurant. This is the safest point in the building away from glass and exterior walls.
- The Hotel will provide an 'all clear' announcement when it is safe to move about the hotel.
